

## Fabric Star Ornament

**Step 1:** Choose 4 fabrics that you like together.



**Step 2:** Cut four 12" X 3 1/4" fabric rectangles.

**Step 3:** Iron the rectangles so they are like double-fold bias tape. (In half, then fold the edges in to the center, and iron again.)



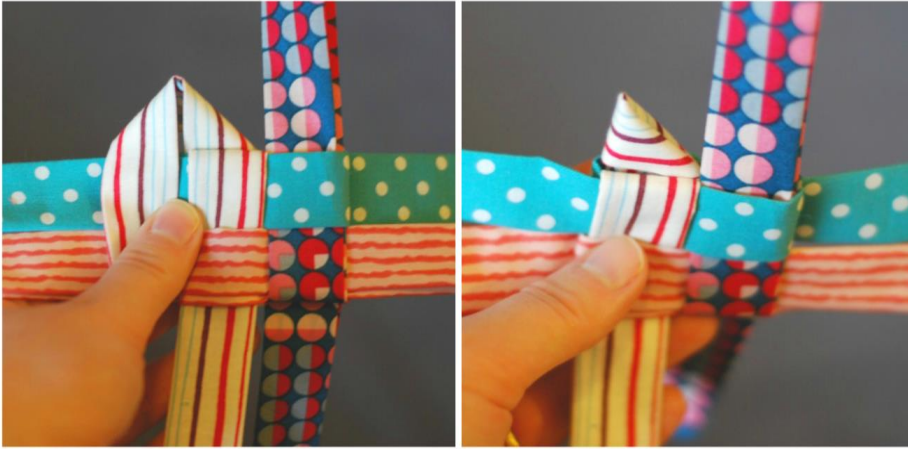
**Step 4:** Fold the strips almost in half, so one end is 2 1/2 – 3" longer than the other. Start weaving them together, so that each strip is sandwiching the previous one. Pull the ends of the last strip through the loop of the first.

**Step 5:** Pull the strips snug. It should now hold together on it's own.



**Step 6:** Flip it over, and weave the long ends together counter-clockwise (just like folding down the top of a cardboard box).

**Step 7:** Pull snug.



**Step 8:** In turn, fold each of the strips back and to the left, forming a triangular point.

**Step 9:** Fold the point in half, and tuck the long end into the ornament with a finger or point turning tool.



**Step 10:** Press with a hot iron and steam to lock the folds in place.

**Step 11:** Use embroidery floss to sew on a loop or sew on a ribbon loop at desired location.
