

Origami Fabric Ornament

Materials:

- two coordinating fabrics
 - a button or charm that will be sewn onto the middle (two buttons for stuffed version)
 - thread/ribbon for hanging
 - matching sewing thread
 - sewing machine
 - circle pattern traced from salad plate, approximately 8 – 8 ½ inches
- iron

1. From both fabrics, cut a circle approximately 8 inches diameter.

2. Sew the pieces together, right sides facing, leaving a small opening for turning.



3. Turn through, iron pieces and sew the opening closed. (Hint: Trim seam allowance with pinking shears before turning for ease in working a smooth edge after turning right side out.

4. Topstitch or add decorative stitching around the edge, if desired, stitching on top of the color to be used on the front of the ornament.

5. Fold the circle in half, and in half again (fourths). Mark the four edge points and the center point of the circle.





6. Stitch the four edge points together.

7. Pin the four point stitches to the center point marked in step 5.

8. Thread needle through to the back and then back to the front to secure.

9. Turn the four corners over to the back, shaping the front to flatten edges. Press folds.

10. Sew a button or charm to the center front and back and then loop a thread or ribbon through one
