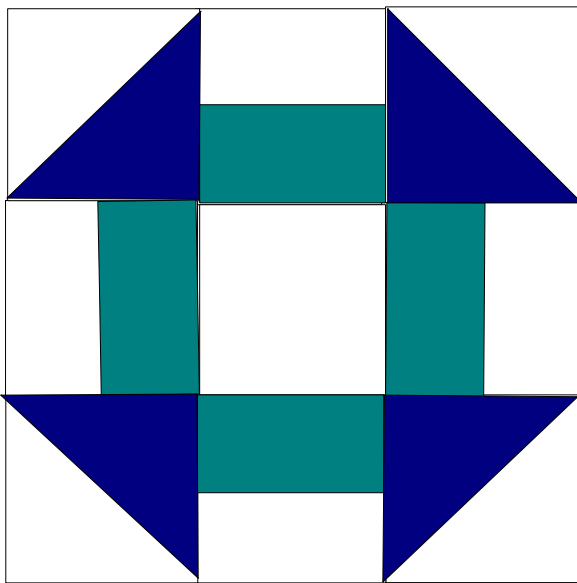


ECCQG January 2017, Block of the Month

Churn Dash Block



Remember, the more blocks that you bring, the more times your name will go in the drawing.

Fabric Colors: Any Blues and a Neutral background. You can use scrappy blues or all one blue.

This blocks will measure 12 ½” unfinished. If your block is too big or small, please check your seam allowance.

Color 1 Neutral background: Cut two 5” squares.
Cut one 4 ½” squares. Cut four 2 ½” x 4 ½” rectangles.

Color 2 Blue: Cut four 2 ½” x 4 ½” rectangles.

Color 3 Blue: Cut two 5” squares.

Make 4 half square triangles using the squares of Color 1 and Color 3. With right sides together, sew a 1/4” seam on either side of a diagonal line. Cut on the diagonal line and square up to 4 ½”. Press toward the Color 3 triangle.

Sew a Color 1 and Color 2 rectangle together longways. Press seam toward the Color 2. Make 4.

Assemble the block as shown in the drawing. Press your seams in different directions for each row. Then away from center row after it is pieced together. Block should measure 12 1/2”, but do not trim.
