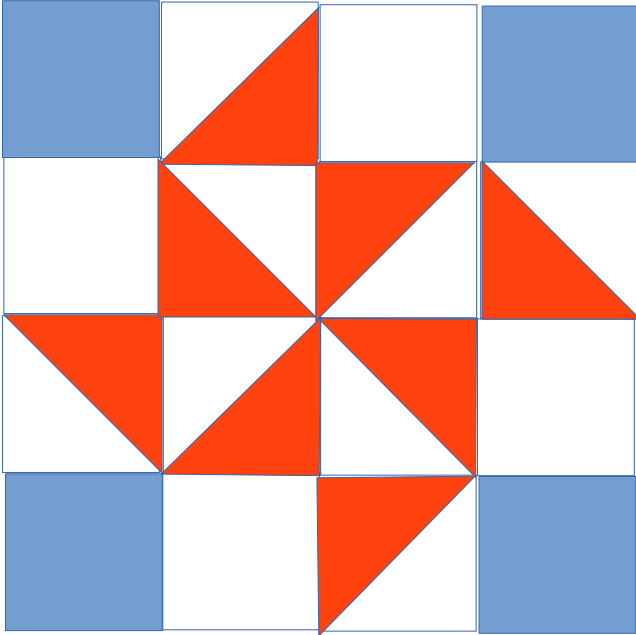


# ECCQG February 2017, Block of the Month

## Double Quartet Block



Remember, the more blocks that you bring, the more times your name will go in the drawing.

**Fabric Colors:** Scrappy medium and dark with a white background.

**Color 1 white background:**  
Cut four  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.  
Cut four  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares.

**Color 2 scrappy dark:** Cut four  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

**Color 3 scrappy medium :** Cut four  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares.

Make 8 half square triangles using the  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares of Color 1 and Color 3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of Color 1 squares. With right sides together, sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on either side of the diagonal line. Cut on the diagonal line and square up to  $3\frac{1}{2}$ ". Press toward the Color 3 triangle.

Assemble the block with a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam as shown in the drawing. Press your seams in different directions for each row.

**Important:** Make sure your block is  $12\frac{1}{2}$ ". Do not trim. If it is larger or smaller, check your seams and redo if necessary. If you do not check your measurements, your block may not easily join properly with other blocks to create a finished quilt.
