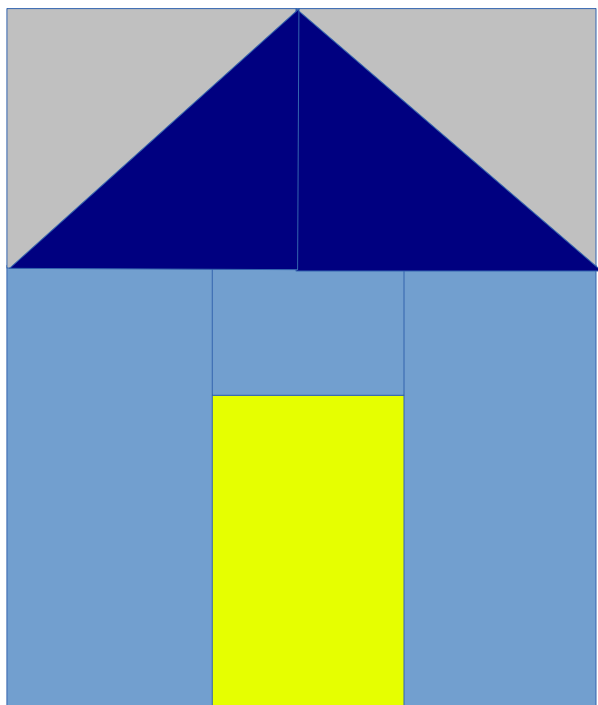


ECCQG March 2017, Block of the Month Little Houses Block



Remember, the more blocks that you bring, the more times your name will go in the drawing.

Fabric Colors: Scrappy with a neutral background for the sky.

Color 1 neutral for sky:

Cut two 3 ¼" squares.

Color 2 for door:

Cut one 2" x 3 ½" rectangle.

Color 3 scrappy for roof : Cut one 3 ¼" x 6" rectangle.

Color 4 scrappy for house: Cut two 2 ½" x 5" rectangles

Cut one 2" x 2" square

- Assemble the block with a ¼" seam.
- Sew the 2" x 2" square of Color 4 to the top of the 2" x 3 ½" rectangle of Color 2.
- Sew a 2 ½" x 5" rectangle of Color 4 to either side of the door piece.
- Make a flying geese unit with the 3 ¼" x 6" rectangle of Color 3 and the two 3 ¼" squares of Color 1. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of both Color 1 squares. Flip and sew onto the Color 3 rectangle to make 1 flying geese unit.
- Sew the flying geese unit to the top of the house unit you made.
- Press. **Block should measure 6" x 7 ¾"**.

Bring to the April Guild meeting.

Important: . Do not trim. If it is larger or smaller, check your seams and redo if necessary. If you do not check your measurements, your block may not easily join properly with other blocks to create a finished quilt.
