CQGEC ~ Divisions & Categories

- The Entries Committee, in conjunction with the Judges and Awards Committee, reserves the right to determine final placement of quilts in categories and to combine or divide categories in order to facilitate judging.
- Divisions are determined by the eligibility of the “maker” of the quilt.
- Quilts that require special handling / packaging MAY NOT be accepted.
- Limit of 3 quilts per person. You may not have more than 2 quilts per category with the exclusion of Non-Judges quilts.

Master Division - *If ANY of the following statements are true; you must enter under the “Master” division:*

- ~ You are a quilter or maker of wearable art and you sell/have sold your work for profit.
- ~ You teach/have taught quilting or wearable art techniques.
- ~ You have had a quilt compete in the Master Division of any quilt show in the past.
- ~ You have published a quilt or wearable art book or pattern.
- ~ You have won a total of two or more blue ribbons in any combination of the following: CQGEC, county, state, national or international quilting competitions.
- ~ You have won a Best of Show Ribbon.
- ~ You have had a quilt or garment juried into a highly prestigious exhibit (Ex: Quilt National, The Houston Quilt Show, etc.).

101 Large Pieced (ONE PERSON)

Any quilt which is LARGER THAN 72” on any one side. Primarily patchwork and machine quilted.

102 Large Pieced (TWO PERSON)

Any quilt which is LARGER THAN 72” on any one side. Primarily patchwork and machine quilted. Two people involved in making of quilt.

103 Small Pieced (ONE PERSON)

No side may EXCEED 72”. Primarily patchwork and machine quilted.

104 Small Pieced (TWO PERSONS)

No side may EXCEED 72”. Primarily patchwork and machine quilted. Two people involved in making of quilt.

105 Large Appliqué (ONE OR TWO PERSONS)

Any quilt which is LARGER THAN 72” on any one side. Primarily appliqué and machine quilted.

106 Small Appliqué (ONE OR TWO PERSONS)

No side may EXCEED 72”. Primarily appliqué and machine quilted.

107 Hand Quilted

Hand quilted any size. Pieced or appliqué.

Artisan Division - *If ALL of the following statements are true, you may enter under the “Artisan” division:*

- ~ You have never sold your work (quilts or wearable art) for profit.
- ~ You have never formally taught quilting or wearable art techniques.
- ~ You have never been classified as a “Master” in the past at any show.
- ~ You have never published a pattern or a book on quilting/wearable art techniques.
- ~ You have won no more than one blue ribbon in any combination of the following: CQGEC, county, state, national or international quilting competitions.
- ~ You have never had a quilt or garment juried into a highly prestigious exhibit (Ex: Quilt National, The Houston Quilt Show, etc.).

201 Large Pieced (ONE PERSON)

Any quilt which is LARGER THAN 72” on any one side. Primarily patchwork and machine quilted.

202 Large Pieced (TWO PERSON)

Any quilt which is LARGER THAN 72” on any one side. Primarily patchwork and machine quilted.

203 Small Pieced (ONE PERSON)

No side may EXCEED 72”. Primarily patchwork and machine quilted.

204 Small Pieced (TWO PERSONS)

No side may EXCEED 72”. Primarily patchwork and machine quilted. Two people were involved in the making.

205 Large Appliqué (ONE OR TWO PERSONS)

Any quilt which is LARGER THAN 72” on any one side. Primarily appliqué and machine quilted.

206 Small Appliqué (ONE OR TWO PERSONS)

No side may EXCEED 72”. Primarily appliqué and machine quilted.

207 Hand Quilted

Hand quilted any size. Pieced or appliqué.

208 First Quilt (ONE or TWO PERSONS)

First quilt made. May be quilted by someone else. (This is not for first quilt entered in a show, but rather first ever quilt.)

Open Division - *Master or Artisan*

301 Miniature Quilts

Any quilt which has no side measuring more than 24”. Any technique may be used. If interior blocks are part of the design, these blocks must measure 4” or less.

302 Mixed Techniques

Piecing and appliqué, of equal amounts, in one quilt. May be hand or machine quilted.

303 Other Techniques

White work, Embroidery, Cathedral Window, Yo-Yo, Crazy Quilts or any other quilt that doesn’t fit into the pieced, appliqué or art quilt categories. May be hand or machine quilted.

304 Group/Friendship

Quilt made by a group of three or more persons using any technique.

305 Art Quilts

Must be ORIGINAL design. Any technique or combination of techniques or materials used in a non traditional way.

306 Theme Quilts (ONE OR TWO PERSON)

“It’s A Carnival!” quilts only. May be pieced or appliqué. May be hand or machine quilted. We reserve the right to separate this group.

307 KITS or BOM Quilts

Quilts you did not pick out the fabric.

Non-Judged Categories

Are exempt from entry fees- only need 1 picture.

401 Displayed: Quilts may utilize any piecing, appliqué or quilting method, may be an individual or group effort, and can be any size less than 96”.

403 – Junior Division -Under 18 years of age: May be quilted by someone else.



IMPORTANT SHOW ENTRY RULES & INSTRUCTIONS:

“It’s A Carnival!”

- Quilts do not need to be finished when you turn the entry form in, but there needs to be a picture of the finished top included with entry form.
- Check-in quilts in person at the Sokol Hall, 2622 TX-34, Ennis, TX 75119, on Wednesday July 13, 2022, from 1 pm to 6:30 pm. Pick-up will be FROM 5:30- 6:30 pm on Saturday July 16, 2022.
- Each quilt must be in its own separate cloth pillowcase or bag.
- Quilts that require special handling / packaging may not be accepted.
- All entries must have two color photos of your entry. Please no larger than 5x7 inches. It can be printed on plain copy paper. It does not need to be photo paper.
- Submission of an entry form does not ensure acceptance of an entry in the show.
- All entries accepted and displayed are at the discretion of the quilt show arrangers. All efforts will be made to accommodate and display all entries.
- The Entries Committee, reserves the right to determine final placement of quilts in categories and to combine or divide categories in order to facilitate judging.
- Quilt must have been made within the past 5 years and cannot have been shown previously at CQGEC quilt show.
- All entries must have a sleeve attached with exception of miniatures.
- How to attach a hanging sleeve to your quilt:

All quilts entered into the show must have a 4 inch diameter hanging sleeve running the entire width of the quilt. Miniature quilts are excluded from this requirement. Quilts that are longer than 90” must have the top of the sleeve attached 90” from the bottom of the quilt.

The sleeve should be sewn firmly to your quilt (not pinned), as this is the only support for the quilt while hanging during the two-day show.

To construct a sleeve: Cut a strip of fabric at least 8 ½” wide and the length equaling the width of the quilt. Make a narrow hem at each end of the strip. Align the long edges, wrong sides together, and sew, making a fabric tube. Stitch the top and bottom edges of the tube down making sure that the top edge of the tube measures 90” from the bottom of the quilt.

If you have not already attached a quilt label, please secure it to the bottom left corner of the quilt back.
